Principal's Announcements—Ms. McDaniel

1. MAP testing complete
2. 2014-2015 enrollment and budget meetings next month
3. Panther Prep meeting for grades 3-8—math and reading IEs during Mid-winter and Spring Break—40 kids each time
4. Tours 2/11 and 2/27—last tour had good attendance
5. Music teacher position will need to be filled by 2/14

PTSA Budget for Students and ASB

1. Funds are not currently available to ASB
2. Middle School Dance will be 2/14
3. 10% from Jog-a-thon proceeds go to ASB. Check will come via Signe from PTSA
4. In the future, we should budget \$1000 from the Jog-a-thon, as the last two years, it's raised \$11k-\$12k
5. Islandwood costs are split over two school years, so we need to remember that the first payment looks small.
6. Islandwood is a big amount from PTSA budget that only affects one grade. Budget is tight.
 - a. Nurse Patterson may not need to be paid out of PTSA budget in future, which will free up budget
 - b. How much will silent auction bring in?
